INTRODUCTION

In the past few weeks we have been deliberating on the topic, “Holy Momentum” with focus on building an atmosphere of momentum in our lives as individuals and as a church; such momentum will see our lives enlarging rather than withdrawing. This study focuses on a few key areas in which we can consciously choose to build momentum rather than risk drawing back.

KEY AREAS

1. TO KEEP MOMENTUM WE MUST KEEP A POSITIVE OUTLOOK & CONVERSATION

Q: On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate your positivity? (1 = negative & 10 = positive.)

Q: Does your language & conversation honestly reflect this?

Q: Do you think your positivity might lift if you changed your language & conversation?

Read Philippians 4:4-8

2. TO KEEP HOLY MOMENTUM WE MUST PARTNER WITH THE RIGHT PEOPLE

God is into partnerships! He calls us to partner with Him and He exhorts us to partner with people who will help our lives move forward.

Read: Proverbs 13:20

Q: Who would you identify as key partners in helping your life enlarge and move forward?

Q: Do you remember a time where your life was not moving forward because of poor choices in relationships; how did that change and what impact did it have?

3. TO KEEP HOLY MOMENTUM WE MUST RETAIN A COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY & PEOPLE

Read: Proverbs 18:1 & Hebrews 10:24-25

Sometimes we can be tempted to draw back in our commitment to people or hold back from being part of community. However, the Bible is clear that isolating ourselves is not God’s plan for us and deprives others.

Q: When are you most tempted to draw back or withhold?

(Leader’s Tip: Perhaps answer first to guide the conversation. Answer honestly yet positively about how you cope with things like tiredness, disappointment, etc.)

Q: How have you overcome this temptation in the past?

Q: How would you go about encouraging someone else to not draw back?

4. TO KEEP HOLY MOMENTUM WE MUST KEEP OUR VOLUNTARY, SACRIFICIAL & GENEROUS SPIRIT

Read: 1 Timothy 6:17-18

Paul reminds Timothy that since God has given richly to us so that we may enjoy, we should therefore be rich in good deeds, generous and willing to share.

Isaiah 32:8 - “...A generous man makes generous plans and by generosity he stands.”

Psalms 37:26 - “They are always generous and lend freely; their children will be a blessing.”
